Invitation to send your papers

It is our great honour and privilege to invite you to <u>send your papers</u> to our conference VIVUS, where you can present and share your findings, experiences and projects with other experts from various areas. Your contributions can be submitted to <u>E-submission</u> on <u>http://www.bc-naklo.si/raziskovalna-dejavnost/konferenca-vivus/aktualno/vivus-2018/</u> and summaries shaped in accordance with template and instructions. Abstracts and papers can be sent to <u>vivus.clanki@bc-naklo.si</u>. Authors can send no more than two papers (with the exception of co-authorship with maximal three submissions). Authors can present their papers in the so called poster session.

A fee invoice will be issued to the address of the payer, stated at your submission. Summaries and papers will be submitted to the review process, after which critical remarks will be sent to authors. Each paper must be supplemented by the authorship statement, signed by at least one of the authors. Collection of abstracts will be published in print and papers in electronic format. Without the payment made by at least one of the authors abstracts and papers will not be published and the certificate can be acquired only after the presentation is carried out. Certificates will contain data from your electronic submission.

Registration and payment of fee are obligatory for all participants of the conference.
